All SIU School of Law students are required to perform at least 35 hours of approved pro bono work prior to Graduation.



Not all work counts

Pro bono work must be law related, uncompensated, supervised by an attorney, and not for academic credit.



You have to report it

Students report their pro bono work by completing the Pro Bono Reporting eform and submitting it via email to probono@siu.edu.

You have until graduation

Pro bono hours can be reported at any time between Orientation and Graduation.

Students are advised to report their hours after they are finished working for an employer.



No requirement, no diploma

If you don't complete the requirement by Graduation, your diploma will be held until you do.
