Applicants for admission by examination to states that have adopted the Uniform Bar Examination (including Illinois, Kentucky, and Missouri, and beginning July 2021, Indiana) are tested on the following subjects. The chart below correlates subject areas tested on the UBE with the SIU School of Law courses that address these subjects. Please note that this list is offered for informational purposes only. While some of the courses are required for graduation (they are indicated by **boldface type**), it is up to each student to decide how many other “bar courses” he or she wishes to take while in law school.
