**Law 672-(2-6) § 001 Judicial Externship<sup>2</sup>** (Brittingham): Open to 2L and 3L students who wish to clerk for a federal or state judge. In lieu of formal class sessions at the law school, the course will be taught online. A cumulative GPA of 2.6 is required, except that students with a cumulative GPA below 2.6 may request special authorization from the instructor to enroll in the course.

**Law 675-(1-6) § 001 Public Interest Externship<sup>2</sup>** (Brittingham): Open to 2L and 3L students. A cumulative GPA of 2.6 is required. In lieu of formal class sessions at the law school, the course will be taught online. An organizational meeting of the course will be conducted at a date and time to be determined by the instructor.
